

NETCENTS Contract Extension as of 9 August 2012

The current NETCENTS contract will be modified to add two options for ordering periods for all CLINs for a period of six months. The first option would commence, if exercised, on 10 September 2012 and end on 31 March 2013. An additional six-month option is included that may extend the ordering period to 30 September 2013 to allow ordering through the end of the fiscal year.

The performance period of task orders written against these ID/IQ contracts may be extended beyond the ordering period ending 9 September 2015, if the option is exercised. All individual task/delivery orders must be awarded prior to the end of the ordering period of 31 March 2013. The contract ceiling amount has been increased to \$10.45B. All orders and modifications must meet the Bona Fide Need Rule relative to the color of money used and associated performance period for each contract action.

Contract Line Item Numbering (CLIN) shall be IAW DFARS 204.71 and PGI 204.71. When multiple contract line items are required, the CLIN structure shall maintain compliance with the basic NETCENTS CLIN structure. For example, all requirements using CLIN 8001 shall contain an "8" in the first digit and a "1" in the last digit and maintain the contract type, Firm Fixed Price, and all requirements using CLIN 8002 shall contain an "8" in the first digit and a "2" in the last digit and maintain the contract type, Cost. This compliance shall be the same for the following CLINs: 8001, 8002, 8003, 8005, 8006, 8007 and 8008.

Contracting activities may use multiple contract line items and subcontract line items when appropriate as long as the "root" CLIN is compliant with the NETCENTS ID/IQ contract.

Examples:

CLIN 8001 - NETCENTRIC Total Solution - Base Yr 10 Sep 2012 - 31 Mar 2013

CLIN 8011 - NETCENTRIC Total Solution - Option One 1 Apr 2013 - 30 Mar 2014

CLIN 8021 - NETCENTRIC Total Solution - Option One 1 Apr 2014 - 30 Mar 2015

Or

subCLIN 8001AA - NETCENTRIC Total Solution - Base Yr 10 Sep 2012 - 31 Mar 2013

subCLIN 8001AB - NETCENTRIC Total Solution - Option One 1 Apr 2013 - 30 Mar 2014

subCLIN 8021AC - NETCENTRIC Total Solution - Option One 1 Apr 2014 - 30 Mar 2015

Additionally, as the NETCENTS-2 contracts begin to be awarded, any new requirements falling within scope of those contracts will be directed to them vice NETCENTS. That is not to say that any existing options on a task/delivery order could not be exercised on the existing NETCENTS contracts, assuming the action falls within the aforementioned information and does not conflict with policy and regulatory constraints. The user would have the option of not exercising any or all options and moving to NETCENTS-2, provided the requirements do fall within scope of it.
