(4) The territories of American Samoa, Guam, and the United States VirginIslands; and

(5) The minor outlying islands of Baker Island, Howland Island, Jarvis Island, Johnston Atoll, Kingman Reef, Midway Islands, Navassa Island, PalmyraAtoll, and Wake Atoll.

(b) Authority.

This clause implements Executive Order 14042, Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors, dated September 9, 2021(published in the Federal Register on September 14, 2021, 86 FR 50985).

(c) Compliance.
