Net-Centric Solutions – 2 (NETCENTS-2) Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Contracts

The NETCENTS-2 family of contracts provides highly flexible contract vehicles delivering mission critical capabilities across the entire range of service and infrastructure support domains enabling Air Force, DoD and other Federal Agencies to effectively and efficiently implement Net-Centric Solutions worldwide. NETCENTS-2 is an enterprise ordering contract that allows customers to acquire Information Technology (IT) service and infrastructure support that leverages USAF buying power to meet strategic sourcing goals, meet or exceed operational Net-Centric requirements, ensure technical compliance with AF and DoD standards, meet or beat required delivery timeframes, and promote Small Business/Support Goals. NETCENTS-2 contracts are the mandatory source for all AF IT services and solutions procurements (see AFI 63-101 and AFMAN 17-1203).

The NETCENTS-2 website provides contact information for the Centralized Customer Service Line, NETCENTS news, and links to NETCENTS-2 documents. The NETCENTS team posts Town Hall Slides and other documents such as government and vendor POC lists, contractor lists (IDIQ, name, contract number, CAGE, and small/large business designation), services standards, user's guides, and contracts. The NETCENTS-2 website provides a link to AFWAY, the Air Force web-based e-commerce solution for purchasing Information Technology services and support. **Customers may email draft PWS documents to netcents@us.af.mil** to request a Scope Analysis. The NETCENTS-2 technical team will review the tasks and recommend the appropriate IDIQ for the requirement (only the task order Contracting Officer can make a scope determination). The technical team also creates and maintains User's Guides and Templates to make writing NETCENTS-2 requirements easier; technical standards and references are already included, which saves the customer significant time in the acquisition process.

Application Services (Small Business (closed for ordering) and Full & Open)

Application Services Small Business ordering period is closed as of 19 June 2019. Application Services is a multiple-award IDIQ contract to provide systems sustainment, development, migration, and integration in addition to netcentric data services, web services, COTS software integration, smart phone/mobile apps; provide sustainment, migration, integration, training, help desk support, testing and operation support for Air Force customers; develop content delivery and presentation services and new mission application that operate in netcentric enterprise environments that exploit SOA infrastructures; and support legacy system sustainment, migration, and the development of new mission capabilities and applications. The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) for Application Services Full & Open IDIQ is 541511 Custom Computer Programming Services contract ceiling is \$3.8B (\$1.56B Full & Open and \$2.26B Small Business). The Full & Open contractors are required to maintain Capability Maturity Model Integration (CMMI) Level III certification throughout the life of the contract. Application Services has Contract Line Item Numbers (CLINS) for Fixed Price (FP), Cost Reimbursement (CR), and Labor Hour (LH) type task orders. The Full & Open IDIQ was awarded 31 March 2015 and the SB IDIQ was awarded 21 June 2012. The total period of performance is 10 years (5 years for a task order); the ordering period is a total of 7 years total if all options are exercised (3 year base period and 4 one-year option periods), and performance may extend 3 years beyond the last day of ordering (contract clause F002). The Full & Open ordering period is 31 March 2015 – 30 March 2018 (base) with ordering period options through 30 March 2022. The Small Business ordering period is closed. Application Services is available for use by AF, Army, Navy, Other DoD components, and Federal

Agencies when the requirement meets any of the following criteria: (1) is related to requirements for interoperability with Air Force capabilities; (2) supports Air Force IT infrastructure, applications, or operations; (3) supports host-tenant arrangements involving Air Force units; or (4) supports joint operations or solutions. Network Operations & Infrastructure Solutions (NetOps) (Small Business and Full & Open)

Network Operations & Infrastructure Solutions (NetOps) is a multiple-award IDIQ contract providing network infrastructure system solutions, operations, and maintenance, systems management, configuration management, and NetOps Core IT services (e.g., e-mail, storage, and directory services); wireless devices/capabilities, information intensive data applications (e.g. video-teleconferencing, imagery, modeling, simulation, streaming video, information management, Everything over IP (EoIP), and Voice over IP (VoIP)). The NAICS for NetOps is 517110 Wired Telecommunications Carriers (SB Size Standard = 1500 employees), and the contract ceiling is \$13.7B (\$7.91B Full & Open and \$5.79B SB). Each contractor is required to maintain ISO 9001:2008 or CMMI Level II certification throughout the life of the contract. NetOps has CLINS for Fixed Price (FP), Cost Reimbursement (CR), and Labor Hour (LH) type task orders. The Full & Open IDIQ was awarded 15 May 2015 and the SB IDIQ was awarded 2 April 2015. The total period of performance is 10 years; the ordering period is a total of 7 years total if all options are exercised, and performance may extend 3 years beyond the last day of ordering (contract clause F002). The Full & Open ordering period is 15 May 2015 – 14 May 2022; performance may extend to 14 May 2025. The Small Business ordering period is 2 April 2015 – 1 April 2022; performance may extend to 1 April 2025. The NetOps IDIQs are available for use by all DoD and Federal Agencies.
